Zebra2 goes wild: Zebra Legacy

Urs Heckmann's workhorse synthesizer **Zebra2** has always been a firm favourite in sound design circles, especially in Hollywood. Many new features have been added over the years, with recent versions including native support for Apple Silicon and VST3. This latest round doesn't add any new features, but actually offers a whole lot more...

Zebra Legacy is Zebra2 plus all of u-he's previously paid soundsets for free, including **The Dark Zebra** with its ZebraHZ version of the plug-in... for a total of 4315 presets. Zebra Legacy replaces all individual products, which are no longer available separately.

According to u-he the highly competitive price of just **99 €** should help them continue maintaining Zebra2 for many years to come while they focus on Zebra3 and beyond.

The deal: If you bought Zebra2 before November 15th you get all the extra Zebra Legacy content for free, and will be eligible for a 30 € upgrade to Zebra3 once that arrives. The upgrade to Zebra3 is free of charge if you also owned The Dark Zebra before November 15th. There is no upgrade path for new Zebra Legacy customers.

Technical notes

Updated minimum requirements, CPU should support SSE4.2 instruction set. For Linux, the minimum required *glibc* version is 2.28, otherwise these plugins will not appear.

macOS 32-bit support has been discontinued.

The Windows installer has been improved to solve common installation issues. Please make sure that the update is installed in the same location as the previous version of Zebra2, and that all existing plugin formats are ticked to ensure they will be updated.

Many presets have been sorted in a more meaningful way, so you might have to reassign your favourites. Windows and Linux users should consider removing the factory library folder before running the new installer.
